Welcome to the exciting
2018 Dust Bowl Jamboree Poker Run!
 Here are some great tips
 to help your day be lots of fun.



- **What is a Poker Run?**

The best hand wins! The object is to collect the best five cards from traditional decks of playing cards. Our Poker Run takes participants on a 50 mile route of Platte County Parks. At each stop volunteers will offer each car a card - "pick a card - any card." They will write down your registration number on the back of the card. At the last stop, which is back at Parkville, you'll turn in your cards. Volunteers will check that all five cards have the same registration number on them, place them into an envelope. Our wheeler-dealer volunteers will review the hand and record the highest possible hand on the outside of the envelope.

- **How Do We Get Involved?**

Fill out the Dust Bowl Jamboree Poker Run Registration Form – submit it along with fees in advance. This allows us to issue a registration number for you. It also informs us of how many cars are out on the route. It also lets us know that everyone has returned safely.

- **Then What?**

When you arrive in Parkville, Main Street will have parking places reserved for our vintage cars. Follow the attendants instructions and get parked. We believe that we will have more cars than parking spaces on Main Street. So if they are full, follow the instructions to the parking lot near the Farmer's Market. Stay with your car until volunteers have checked you in and car number is affixed to the windshield. You will be given a turn-by-turn set of instructions to follow for the route. Then enjoy the Pancake Breakfast at American Legion Post #318!



- **Ready? Set? Go!**

At 9:30 a.m., we'll start the cars along the Poker Run. The cars will be staggered so there isn't a county-wide traffic jam. Follow the instructions and stay on the Route! Visit each park location, receive your card and then continue. The route returns you to Parkville. Drive to the check-in station, turn in your cards, and then park. By now, it will be a normal busy Saturday so there may not be any parking on Main Street. Use the Farmers Market lot.

- **Enjoy Parkville.**

The shops and stores will be open on your return. Then, make your way down to English Landing Park.

- **Music Time!**

At 12 p.m. our Dust Bowl Jamboree Open Jam Session begins in Shelter #X. Here you can hear talented players pick, grin, sing, clap and tap their toes. At 2 p.m., the Dust Bowl Concert starts with two wonderful groups! The Matchsellers and Bill and the Belles! Please bring lawn chairs and a cooler if your like. In Shelter #XX, Parkville's American Legion Post #318 will hold a beer/wine garden. They'll also have details about the new Parkville Veterans Memorial Project.

- **Hey, Who Won the Poker Run?**

At some point during the Dust Bowl Concert we'll announce the winner. Hope its you!
